Tony joined the Inova Health Foundation in September 2011, bringing more than 30 years of fundraising, marketing and communications experience serving not-for-profit organizations in the U.S. and around the world.

In the six years Tony has been at the helm of the Inova Health Foundation, over \$160 million has been raised in support of Inova's programs and services, including a \$50 million gift to create the Inova Schar Cancer Institute, the largest in Inova's history.

Prior to coming to Inova, Tony was the Senior Vice President for Development and Communications for Project HOPE, the People to People Health Foundation. He was responsible for revenue development, marketing, global communications and government relations. During his seven years there, the global health and humanitarian assistance non-profit grew from \$120 million to \$192 million and expanded the organizational footprint from 28 to 36 countries. During his tenure with Project HOPE, Tony traveled extensively in Africa, Asia, Central and South America.

Previously, Tony served as a Vice President with Ketchum, a fundraising and communications agency. He was appointed the youngest member of the senior leadership team for the firm, as well as serving as a group leader within the healthcare practice. Some of his clients included the Adventist Health System, Catholic Healthcare West, Johnson & Johnson, Merck and Philips Medical System.

He is active in the community serving in volunteer leadership positions for the Northern Virginia Community College Foundation Board and The Boy Scouts of America, National Capital Council.
